Church History

Greater Bible Way Apostolic Temple was organized June 3, 1962 by its founder the late Bishop Samuel Allen Sr. After seeing a need to continue in the same theological climate as the Apostles, Bishop Allen conducted his first service in a burned-out four room house, located at 715 Woodruff Avenue with his wife, Mother O. R. Allen, their four children, Samuel Jr., Linda, Patricia, and Anthony, and Louella Allen Avery. Bishop Allen was determined to build a work for the Lord. In about one week, Mother Annie Lee and her two little girls became the first members to unite with the newly organized church. One week later, Mother Cora Shelby and her children joined. Services were held at a store front, located at 212 South Chicago Street. Due to financial difficulties the church was forced to move. Elder and Mother George Fogle allowed Bishop Allen to hold church services in their garage. The church later moved to the basement of the pastor's home at 1418 Woodruff Road. The church remained there until finances could be raised to erect a new building.

In 1965, the first church was built at 1528 Woodruff Road. The church grew until a larger building was needed. In 1970, a new sanctuary was built and the old one was used for Sunday school rooms. In 1976, God revealed to Bishop Allen that "77" was the year for double blessing and sweeping victory and that the church would move to a larger edifice.

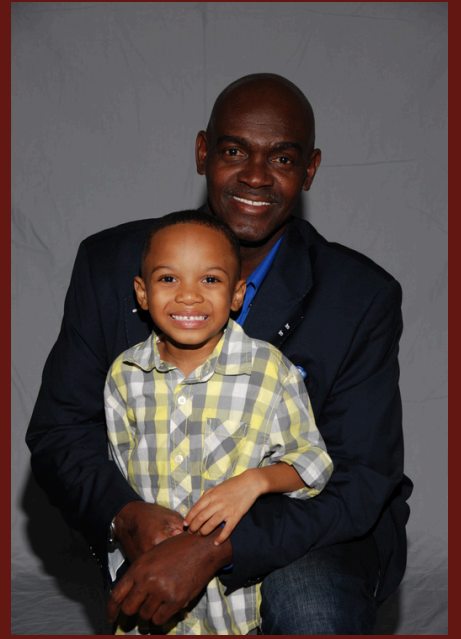
On December 31, 1977, we moved into our present edifice on Brown and Leach Avenue. It has been 62 years and Greater Bible Way is still marching to victory and continuing in the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

Bishop Allen continued to feed the flock of God for 43 years until his transition on February 23, 2005. He had been given the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind. He has given knowledge and understanding of God's word to all that he came in contact with.

When the life of Bishop Samuel Allen came to a close, the vision to build a work for the Lord continued. We were given yet another great leader in the person of Bishop Bryan S. Allen. Under his competent leadership, he took the church to higher heights in God, souls were delivered and saved in the name of Jesus Christ.

In February 2023, Bishop Bryan S. Allen answered his calling to continue his work for the Lord in the Arizona. Before his departure, Bishop instated Pastor Steffan Michael Allen to continue on working for the Lord in Illinois. With Pastor Allen's feet firmly planted on the foundation laid in 1962, his ministry is taking a fresh approach to "Making Heaven Too Small"
